# Korean Language Programs

There are regular and short term courses in the IIE Korean Language Center. The regular course is designed to provide intensive instruction for students in speaking, listening, writing, and reading skills of the Korean language. The ten-week course will meet five times a week for four hours each day and is divided into six levels: beginning 1, beginning 2, intermediate 1, intermediate 2, advanced 1, and advanced 2. The level will be determined by a placement test and each class will consist of fifteen students or less. The short term course is designed to teach students Korean intensively and expose them to Korean culture in a short period of time. The three-week course will meet five times a week. There will be a culture experience class about 3 times a week.
